SPORTING LICENCES

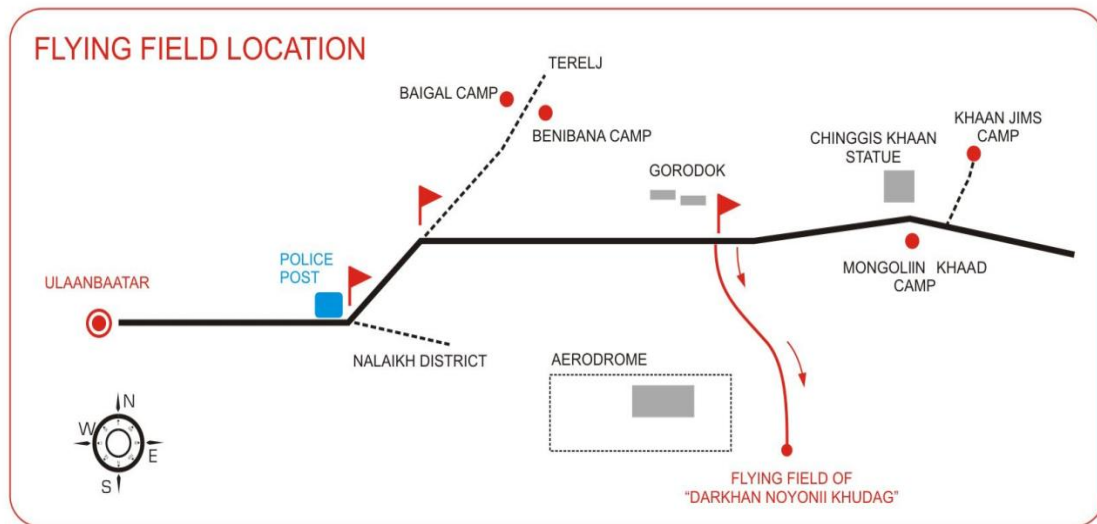
Each competitor and team manager must have an FAI Sporting Licence issued by his National Airport Control valid for 2019 and entered in the FAI Sporting Licence Database.

PROTEST FEE

The protest fee is 35 EUR.

FLYING SITE LOCATION

The field of “Darkhan Noyonii Khudag” is approximately 50 km to the east from city of Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia. There is an area of at least 7 km by 5 km of short smooth grass.



The average height above sea level (altitude) of the flying field is about 1,400 meters.



Flying Site – the Field of “Darkhan Noyonii Khudag” (47°71’43.80”, 107°42’47.74”)

AWARDS

Medals and diplomas as well as trophies will be awarded to the first three in individual and junior classifications in F1A, F1B, F1C, F1G, F1H, F1P.

ENTRY FEE

F1A, B, C, G, H, P – 50 EUR (Additional Category – 25 EUR);

Juniors F1A, B, C, H, G, P – 10 EUR (Additional Category – Free or no fee);

Note: The entry fee covers participation in the competition, lunch on contest day at the flying field, trophies and gifts.

BANQUET

The banquet price per person is 35 EUR.

F1C AND F1P FUEL

F1C fuel – 80% Methanol and 20% Castor Oil will be used in the Competitions. If you need more fuel for training or pure Methanol for motors and models cleaning, please mark quantity in the Entry Form. If you want to buy the extra F1C fuel, pure Methanol, and Starter Battery for purchase, please send order to us in advance. Payment at the Registration.

Inform us about your suggestion for F1C and F1P fuels and Starter Battery.

ACCOMMODATION

Camp hotels are available approximately 5-30 km distances from the flying field. Total number of persons in each hotel is 30-60. The price for the hotels with breakfast is from 30 to 45 EUR per person. List of the hotels is to be announced on the official web site.

Camping will be arranged for competition participants at the flying site. Refreshments, drinks and food as well as shower on the competitions days will be available at the flying field.

MEAL

Breakfast, lunch and dinner shall be had at the accommodation places. Lunch will be organized on daily basis at the flying field. At the flying field it will be possible to buy refreshments, drinks and food on the competitions days.

Cafe – at the camp site, snack at the flying site.

HOW TO REACH ULAANBAATAR

- by direct flight from: Germany (Berlin, Frankfurt), Japan (Tokyo, Osaka), China (Beijing, Tainjin, Huhhot), Hong-Kong, Russia (Moscow, Irkutsk, Ulaan-Ude), Korea (Seoul), Singapore, and Turkey (Istanbul);
- by car (from Ulaan-Ude and Irkutsk);
- by train (Beijing, Moscow, Irkutsk, and Ulaan-Ude).

TRANSPORTATION SERVICE

ANTI-DOPING

If a competitor has to take any of the substances listed on the WADA Prohibited List for a medical condition, then he must have a Therapeutic Use Exemption from the FAI.

INSURANCE

The Organizer will provide third party insurance cover to all participants for accidents involving injury to others or damage to property according to the host country's legislation. All the participants and visitors must have their own health insurance to cover illness and accidents.

MEDICAL TEAM

During the Competitions, a doctor and an emergency will be present at the flying field.

ELECTRICITY

For electrical appliances and charging equipments, electricity in Mongolia operates on 220 Volts (50 Hz).

LOST MODELS

The Organizer will provide small adhesive labels for models in case they fly away. The text on the label will be published and provided at the registration site.

RESPONSIBILITIES

All competitors shall be responsible for their own aeromodel crash and loss during the Competitions. They are also responsible for their air flight, hotel and other trip expenses.

WEATHER
